Information Collection

This notice applies to all information collected or submitted on the assessment survey sites for the Leadership Versatility Index®, Pulse Check®, and Progress Report®. KLS collects only as much personal information as we need for specific, identified purposes, and we will not use it for other purposes without obtaining your consent.

We use security techniques, including encryption and secure servers, to protect against unauthorized access to transmitted information used for assessment and research purposes. KLS does not store, use or share your information for any other purpose.

Use of Information

We use the information you provide about yourself for assessment and research purposes. KLS keeps your personal information for as long as required to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected, or as permitted by law.

Information Security

We are very much aware of Internet users' concerns about security. KLS takes technical, contractual, administrative and physical steps to protect against unauthorized access to and disclosure of individually identifiable information. These steps can include firewalls, secure socket layers, password verification,
